We're offering grants of up to £1000 to help community groups to run activities during British Science Week for people who are underrepresented in science. These people include those who are:

- from ethnic minorities
- with low socio-economic status, including disadvantage through education and income
- with a physical or mental condition or impairment
- living in a remote and rural location (i.e. a settlement of less than 10,000 people)
- girls and women \*
- \* For community groups working with girls and women, we prioritise those who work with at least one other underrepresented group.
