**Murdering the Devil**

**Manon**

A former French Resistance activist rescues Manon from villagers who want to lynch her for collaborating with the Nazis. They move to Paris, but their relationship quickly turns stormy after they get involved in profiteering, prostitution and murder. 1hr 40m. French with subtitles.
